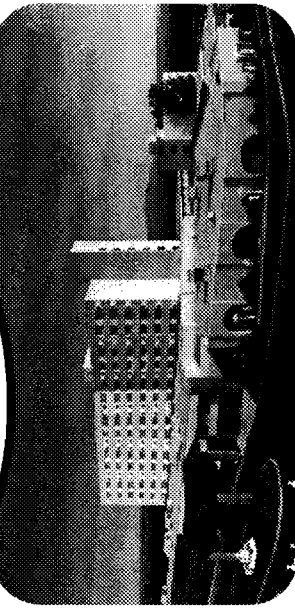

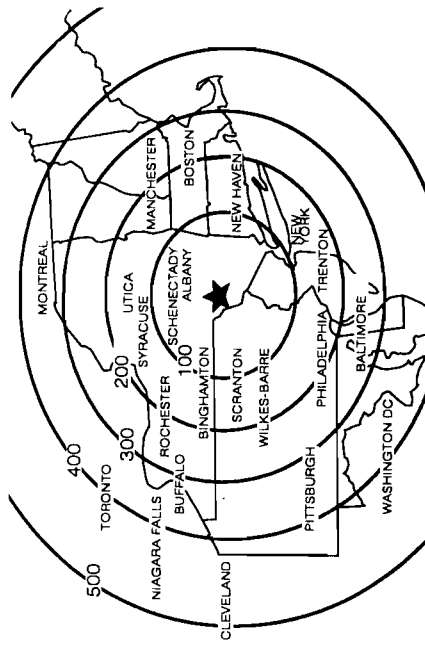

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

CAR: (1) From NYC take NYS Thruway North (I-87) to Harriman (Exit 16) to Route 17 West. Exit 113 (Wurtsboro) onto Route 209 North approximately 20 miles to Rte. 44/55. Turn right onto 44/55, 1.5 miles then left at Hudson Valley Resort sign. Proceed one mile to stop sign. Turn left onto Lower Granite Road. Resort is 1/2 mile ahead on left.
 (2) From New Jersey and South take NJ Turnpike to Garden State Parkway to NYS Thruway (I-87) and follow NYC directions. (3) From Southern Tier - Take Route 81 to Binghamton, Route 17 East to Exit 113 and follow NYC directions above. (4) From Upstate NY take NYS Thruway South to Exit 19 (Kingston), Route 28 (Pine Hill) to Route 209 South to Kertihonkson. Turn left onto Route 44/55 and follow directions above. (5) From Massachusetts take the MA Pike (I-90) to NYS thruway (I-87) South and follow directions from Upstate NY. (6) From PA take I-84 East to Exit 11 (Matamoras). Pick up Route 209 North and follow NYC directions above. (7) From CT take I-84 West to Exit 75 picking up NYS Thruway (I-87) and follow NYC directions above. (8) From Washington DC take I-95 North to the NJ Turnpike following NJ directions above. (9) From Stewart Airport turn left onto Route 207 East. Right onto Route 300. Stay in right lane and at first major intersection turn right onto Route 17K. At the next light turn left onto NYS Thruway (I-87) and follow NYC directions above.

BUS: Short Line Bus at Port Authority Bus Terminal (212-736-4700) to Kertihonkson, NY. Call (845) 626-8888 prior to arrival for hotel car to meet you. (No Charge for Car Service)

AIRLINE SERVICE: to Stewart Airport, Newburgh, NY (845) 564-2100 — Northwest Airlines, Jet Blue, Delta Airlines and US Air (Hotel Shuttle \$40.00 per person each way). For hotel shuttle please provide Stardust Dance Productions with flight information at least one week prior to arrival.

STARDUST DANCE FACULTY

FRAN CHESLEIGH — is the dance director and emcee for Stardust Dance Productions. An accomplished musician and dancer, Fran specializes in Tango. He co-produced the AMC documentary "Gotta Dance", is currently writing a book on Palladium era Mambo and teaches at Dance Manhattan.

DONNA DE SIMONE — co-owner, director and choreographer of Dance Odyssey and Entertainment Director for Stardust. Donna holds numerous Ballroom and Latin Titles. She has performed throughout the US and China as a solo and ensemble dancer.

JACKIE HORNER — a long standing member of Dance Educators of America, Jackie has an extensive background in Ballroom, Latin and performing arts. She was the story consultant and inspiration for the film "Dirty Dancing".

NICK LECAKES — Nick's 48 year career as an instructor has taken him from Hawaii to Puerto Rico where he was a featured dancer on TV as well as a choreographer. Long affiliated with Arthur Murray in addition to teaching jazz for the last 10 years, he currently works with Dance Manhattan.

NORTON HYMAN — toured the US as a dance professional for over 20 years as a member of the acclaimed dance team Norton and Patricia. Now retired from stage and screen he teaches ballroom dance with his wife AGI in Monticello, NY.

BEN MURTHA & ESTHER ODESCALCHI — Esther began dancing in Budapest at the age of twelve. Ben has taught at Dale, Arthur Murray, Fred Astaire and other leading dance studios across the country. They are co-owners of E&B Dance Academy.

FRANK ELIA — was a night club performer before joining Dance Educators of America in the 1970's. At present he teaches dance for a number of colleges and Fortune 500 companies in addition to working as a professional DJ. He is associated with various dance studios in Westchester, NY specializing in choreography for wedding couples.

NORMA GRANOFSKY — has been teaching ballroom dancing for all of her adult life, including 5 years on the staff of the world renowned Grossinger Resort and Country Club. She has taught master classes for Dance Educators of America, performed at Madison Square Garden and recently choreographed a show at Westbury Music Fair. She currently teaches independently on Long Island, NY.

GEORGE MADERSKI — began dancing at the age of six. In 1974, he performed with the Joffrey Ballet and in 1986 and 1988 with the American Ballroom Theater. He won first place in theatrical and cabaret at the American Star Ball, The Professional Harvest Moon Ball, and second place at the Texas Challenge, as well as Classique Du Quebec. He has taught for Fred Astaire, Arthur Murray, and many independent dance studios. At present, he teaches privately in Merrick, NY, as well as adult education classes in Nassau County.

PETER LOCURATOLO — is a Ballroom, Swing and Latin dance performer who has been featured at resorts, clubs and dance events throughout the US. He is a member of Dance Masters of America who currently teaches and coaches at Dance Manhattan.

CARLOS CAÑEDO — Carlos Cañedo began performing professionally at age 14 and has performed throughout Argentina, Europe, Canada, Mexico, and the United States. He was in the cast of Swango, and performed in Tango Y Vida. Carlos has performed at New York's prestigious Town Hall in Tango Pour La Milonga, and is a cast member of Fusion Tango. Carlos was guest choreographer for New York's Atrevide Dance Company. He has also choreographed cast members of the hit Broadway show Forever Tango in his own company.

ANAIS HAVEN — Anais's ballet training began at 10 with private coaching from a Vaganova Academy. At 16, she became the youngest soloist with the New York Ballet. A year later, she was made a soloist with the Metropolitan Ballet Company and has been trained by Cornell Crabtree, Nina Buisson, and Deborah Wingert.

MANUEL ROJAS — Manuel Rojas has received world wide acclaim as a ballet, modern, ballroom and Latin dancer, teacher and choreographer throughout Germany, South America, South Africa, Japan and China. He trained and performed with the Missouri State Ballet, The Alvin Ailey Repertory Theater and has been a featured dancer in Swing Dance America, Tango Fusion and Forever Swing. He is currently in his 10th season as a principle dancer for the internationally renowned Michael Mao Dance Company.

NATALIA SOSNINA — Natalia is a 1st place Ballroom and Latin champion in her native Russia, as well as France, England, Austria, Ukrain and Belgrad. She began her dance training at the age of 9 with an early focus on Latin Ballroom Dancing, graduating to a current focus on IOC sanctioned DanceSport. During that 12 year study period she was personally trained by some of Russia's most noted dance luminaries. Currently she is training for the 2012 London Olympics.

RANDY & VIKTORIJA DIAS — Randy has been dancing since 1988 and is a member of the National Dance Council of America and the Imperial Society of Teachers. Viktorija started her dance career at the age of 7 in Latvia where she became a winner of many national dance competitions there and in the USSR. In 2003 their partnership was born and together they have an impressive list of accomplishments: 2008 Eastern U.S. Professional Smooth Champions, Atlanta Open Dancesport Champions, R.F. Dance Houston, Emerald Ball Dancesport Champions, U.S. Rising Star American Ballroom Silver Medalists, Yuletide Ball Dancesport Champions.

SERGEI SLUSSKY & POLINA KIRILLOVA — currently compete professionally in international standard and Latin. Together, they successfully operate the American Ballroom Dance Academy which is a chain of ballroom dance studios in the state of Maine, where they present the complete range of Ballroom and Latin dances of both styles. They are members of the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dance.

TEDDY KERN — Co-owner and artistic director of Dance Manhattan in NYC as well as director of the American Swing Dance Championship and Boogie Dance Productions, Inc. Teddy is also resident choreographer of the Viennese Opera Ball.

DAVID PARIS — teaches and performs a unique blend of aerial acrobatics. He first studied salsa for 7 years under Eddie Torres and Razzmatazz system and has since produced two instructional video series, "Salsa For Gringos" and "Salsa Lifts and Aerials." Dave trains in ballet, pilates, Latin hustle, dance lifts, extreme dancing, circus partner doubles, and handstands. By night, Dave teaches Dance Acrobatics at dozens of International Events around the world, including Holland, Spain, Italy, Germany, England, China, Korea, Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico, and Canada.

ZOË KLEIN — is a dancer, light designer and acrobat from Brooklyn. Her interest in Latin Music, Dance & Culture led her to study Afro-Cuban folkloric dance and drumming at Nacional Escuela Del Arte in Havana. In 2005 Dave Paris and Zoë formed Paradizo Dance, an acrobatic dance company specializing in high level stunts combined with dance. Together they perform at International Events worldwide. Just recently they toured Tokyo, Hong Kong, Singapore, Thailand, Australia, and New Zealand.

JOE PALMER — has been competing and teaching ballroom, Latin and swing for over 14 years. He majored in dance education at New York University and has taught for NYU, Pratt University and Columbia University and is a regular teacher at Lincoln Center's yearly summer festival. Joe has been a featured dancer and choreographer for Forever Swing National Tour, DARREN World Tour. He has created, produced and directed many original shows including *Measurements*; *The Makings of a New Musical* and most recently an all jazz version of Lewis Carroll's *Alice in Wonderland*.

SUZANNE TEMPLE — brings to Dance Manhattan a wide range of talents in dance. Her interests include, instruction, performance and choreography in many styles and she particularly enjoys working with beginning dancers and couples. Suzanne first taught partner dances at the Arizona Ballroom Company in 2003, where she earned certifications in bronze and silver level American Smooth ballroom and competed nationally in International Style ballroom.

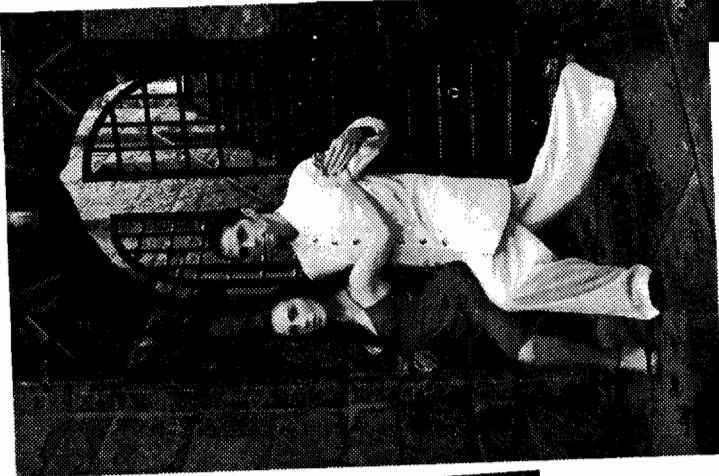

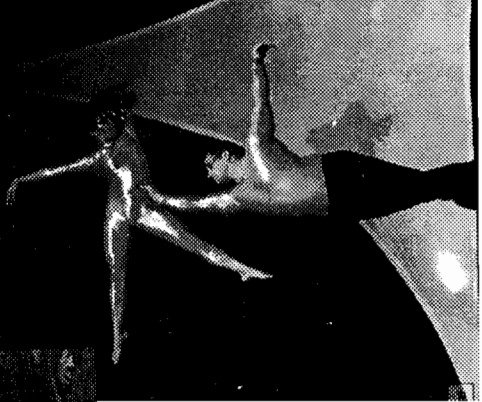
