A Short Trip to this Great Dance Weekend at HUDSON VALLEY RESORT

Kerhonkson, NY

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

CAR: (1) From NYC take NYS Thruway North (I-87) to Harriman (Exit 16) to Route 17 West. Exit 113 (Wurtsboro) onto Route 209 North approximately 20 miles to Rte. 44/55. Turn right onto 44/55, 1.5 miles then left at Hudson Valley Resort sign. Proceed one mile to stop sign. Turn left onto Lower Granite Road. Resort is 1/2 mile ahead on left. (2) From New Jersey and South take NJ Turnpike to Garden State Parkway to NYS Thruway (I-87) and follow NYC directions. (3) From Southern Tier - Take Route 81 to Binghamton, Route 17 East to Exit 113 and follow NYC directions above. (4) From Upstate NY take NYS Thruway South to Exit 19 (Kingston), Route 28 (Pine Hill) to Route 209 South to Kerhonkson. Turn left onto Route 44/55 and follow directions above. (5) From Massachusetts take the MA Pike (I-90) to NYS thruway (I-87) South and follow directions from Upstate NY. (6) From PA take I-84 East to Exit 11 (Matamoras). Pick up Route 209 North and follow NYC directions above. (7) From CT take I-84 West to Exit 75 picking up NYS Thruway (I-87) and follow NYC directions above. (8) From Washington DC take I-95 North to the NJ Turnpike following NJ directions above. (9) From Stewart Airport turn left onto Route 207 East. Right onto Route 300. Stay in right lane and at first major intersection turn right onto Route 17K. At the next light turn left onto NYS Thruway (I-87) and follow NYC directions above.

BUS: Short Line Bus at Port Authority Bus Terminal (212-736-4700) to Kerhonkson, NY. Call (845) 626-8888 prior to arrival for hotel car to meet you. (No Charge for Car Service)

AIRLINE SERVICE: to Stewart Airport, Newburgh, NY (845) 564-2100 — Northwest Airlines, Jet Blue, Delta Airlines and US Air (Hotel Shuttle \$40.00 per person each way). For hotel shuttle please provide Stardust Dance Productions with flight information at least one week prior to arrival.

STARDUST DANCE FACULTY

FRAN CHESLEIGH — is the dance director and emcee for Stardust Dance Productions. An accomplished musician and dancer, Fran specializes in Tango. He co-produced the AMC documentary "Gotta Dance", is currently writing a book on Palladium era Mambo and teaches at Dance Manhattan.

DONNA DE SIMONE — co-owner, director and choreographer of Dance Odyssey and Entertainment Director for Stardust, Donna holds numerous Ballroom and Latin Titles. She has performed throughout the US and China as a solo and ensemble dancer.

JACKIE HORNER — a long standing member of Dance Educators of America, Jackie has an extensive background in Ballroom, Latin and performing arts. She was the story consultant and inspiration for the film "Dirty Dancing".

NICK LECAKES — Nick's 48 year career as an instructor has taken him from Hawaii to Puerto Rico where he was a featured dancer on TV as well as a choreographer. Long affiliated with Arthur Murray in addition to teaching jazz for the last 10 years, he currently works with Dance Manhattan.

NORTON HYMAN — toured the US as a dance professional for over 20 years as a member of the acclaimed dance team Norton and Patricia. Now retired from stage and screen he teaches ballroom dance with his wife AGI in Monticello, NY.

BEN MURTHA & ESTHER ODESCALCHI — Esther began dancing in Budapest at the age of twelve. Ben has taught at Dale, Arthur Murray, Fred Astaire and other leading dance studios across the country. They are co-owners of E&B Dance Academy.

FRANK ELIA — was a night club performer before joining Dance Educators of America in the 1970's. At present he teaches dance for a number of colleges and Fortune 500 companies in addition to working as a professional DJ. He is associated with various dance studios in Westchester, NY specializing in choreography for wedding couples.

NORMA GRANOFSKY — has been teaching ballroom dancing for all of her adult life, including 5 years on the staff of the world renowned Grossinger Resort and Country Club. She has taught master classes for Dance Educators of America, performed at Madison Square Garden and recently choreographed a show at Westbury Music Fair. She currently teaches independently on Long Island, NY.

SERGEI SLUSSKY & POLINA KIRILLOVA — currently compete professionally in international standard and Latin. Together, they successfully operate the American Ballroom Dance Academy which is a chain of ballroom dance studios in the state of Maine, where they present the complete range of Ballroom and Latin dances of both styles. They are members of the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dance.



BILLY FAJARDO — has over 30 years of dance experience, founded and danced with Dance Dimensions, appearing on Don Kirshner's Rock Concert for 4 seasons. He has performed at Madison Square Garden, Carnegie Hall, Radio City and top venues around the world. In 2003 his contributions to the world of dance as a performer and choreographer to the stars were recognized with a Lifetime Achievement Award from Albert Torres Productions.

KATIE MARLOW — has been performing professionally since 1981 appearing in cabaret reviews, television (Miami Vice), theater and film (A Chorus Line). In 1995 she founded Dancesation Entertainment, an upscale production company that caters to Fortune 500 corporations. Bill and Katie are recipients of the Augie and Margo Rodriguez award for exemplary and inspirational contributions to the world of dance and are in constant demand on the Ballroom, Hustle, Salsa and Swing dance circuits.

VALERIA CARMEL — has been performing, teaching, and touring all over the United States, Europe, and Argentina for ten years. She brings to tango a ballet and jazz background and has developed a special tango attitude class series for women. Her teaching is known to be exacting, clear, and generous. Valeria's charismatic teaching and sympathetic qualities add a special dimension.

JESUS VELAZQUEZ — is the most sought after dancer on YouTube, and has also been acclaimed on stages around the world with the most prestigious tango productions: Tangokinesis; Forever Tango; Tango x 2, Tango Passion; and the Sexteto Mayor. He has been featured in the movies Evita and Saura's Tango. A native of Santiago Del Estero, Jesus has been touring the United States and Europe as a teaching maestro. Carmel and Velquez form a handsome and exciting dance couple sharing solid teaching ethics and experience.

MARK JAMES — A member of the Hustle Hall of Fame and 1999's Around the Floor Teacher of the Year Mark holds over 30 championship titles. He is an independent teacher, coach and choreographer with extensive training in American and International Rhythm and Smooth. He lives, performs and teaches on Long Island where he hosts the popular Dance Zone.

KAREN LUPO — is a much sought after coach, teacher and choreographer known for her elegant and sensual style. She is a former American Rhythm champion who is a regular performer in and around NYC as well as on international cruise ships. She and her partner Mark James integrate their exciting performances with lifts and drops for added punch!

LOU BROCK — Ballroom Dancer/Comedian/Actor - has been entertaining for over 20 years. As a dancer, Lou was a member of the internationally acclaimed American Ballroom Theater. Lou continues to appear on stage and in film, recently featured dancing in the films Mona Lisa Smile, The Stepford Wives, and Disney's film Enchanted. The New York Times proclaimed his style, "slyly sophisticated" and declared it a rare treat for the audience. Lou Brock has taught at NYU and has been an in house teacher at Dance Manhattan for over fifteen years.

HEATHER GEHRING — trained in ballet from an early age at Boston Ballet and School of American Ballet and performed with the Hartford Ballet. She then moved on to compete in ballroom dancing and to explore other dance styles. She is founder and director of contemporary dance company Gehring Dancetheatre. Heather currently works out of Garden State Ballet and Dance Manhattan, as well as doing professional shows with her dance partner Lou Brock.

NIKOLAI SCHPAKOVE — is an International Latin competitor who is currently on the US Professional Ballroom Dance circuit. He started dancing in his native Russia at the age of 5. In addition to competing, he also teaches, performs, and judges amateur competitions with his partner Tatiana.

TATIANA BANKO — also trained in Russia and most recently placed second in the Las Vegas Showdown (Latin) and first in the California Open and Desert Classic (Rising Star).

GEORGE MADERSKI — began dancing at the age of six. In 1974, he performed with the Joffrey Ballet and in 1986 and 1988 with the American Ballroom Theater. He won first place in theatrical and cabaret at the American Star Ball, The Professional Harvest Moon Ball, and second place at the Texas Challenge, as well as Classique Du Quebec. He has taught for Fred Astaire, Arthur Murray, and many independent dance studios. At present, he teaches privately in Merrick, NY, as well as adult education classes in Nassau County.

TEDDY KERN — Co-owner and artistic director of Dance Manhattan in NYC as well as director of the American Swing Dance Championship and Boogie Dance Productions, Inc. Teddy is also resident choreographer of the Viennese Opera Ball.

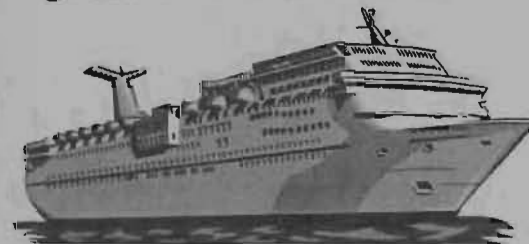
