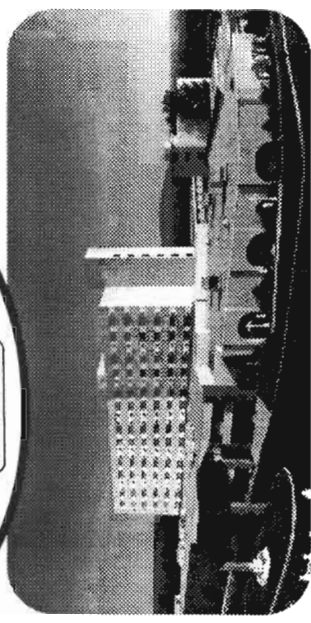

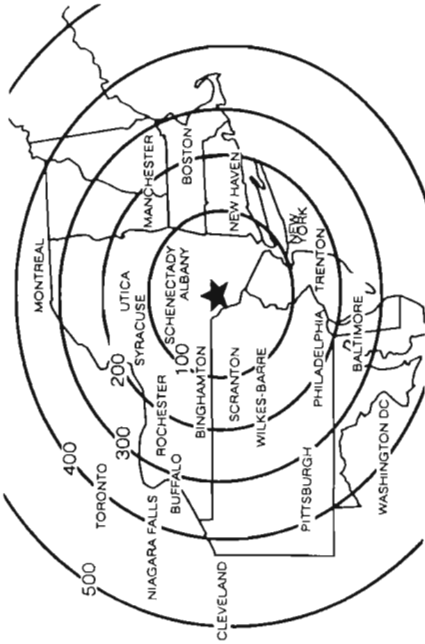

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS
CAR: (1) From NYC take NYS Thruway North (I-87) to Harriman (Exit 16) to Route 17 West. Exit 113 (Wurtsboro) onto Route 209 North approximately 20 miles to Rte. 44/55. Turn right onto 44/55, 1.5 miles then left at Hudson Valley Resort sign. Proceed one mile to stop sign. Turn left onto Lower Granite Road. Resort is 1/2 mile ahead on left.
 (2) From New Jersey and South take NJ Turnpike to Garden State Parkway to NYS Thruway (I-87) and follow NYC directions. (3) From Southern Tier - Take Route 81 to Binghamton, Route 17 East to Exit 113 and follow NYC directions above. (4) From Upstate NY take NYS Thruway South to Exit 19 (Kingston), Route 28 (Pine Hill) to Route 209 South to Kerhonkson. Turn left onto Route 44/55 and follow directions above. (5) From Massachusetts take the MA Pike (I-90) to NYS thruway (I-87) South and follow directions from Upstate NY. (6) From PA take I-84 East to Exit 11 (Matamoras). Pick up Route 209 North and follow NYC directions above. (7) From CT take I-84 West to Exit 7S picking up NYS Thruway (I-87) and follow NYC directions above. (8) From Washington DC take I-95 North to the NJ Turnpike following NJ directions above. (9) From Stewart Airport turn left onto Route 207 East. Right onto Route 300. Stay in right lane and at first major intersection turn right onto Route 17K. At the next light turn left onto NYS Thruway (I-87) and follow NYC directions above.
BUS: Short Line Bus at Port Authority Bus Terminal (212-736-4700) to Kerhonkson, NY. Call (845) 626-8888 prior to arrival for hotel car to meet you. (No Charge for Car Service)
AIRLINE SERVICE: to Stewart Airport, Newburgh, NY (845) 564-2100 — Northwest Airlines, Jet Blue, Delta Airlines and US Air (Hotel Shuttle \$40.00 per person each way). For hotel shuttle please provide Stardust Dance Productions with flight information at least one week prior to arrival.

STARDUST DANCE FACULTY

FRAN CHESLEIGH — is the dance director and emcee for Stardust Dance Productions. An accomplished musician and dancer, Fran specializes in Tango. He co-produced the AMC documentary "Gotta Dance", is currently writing a book on Palladium era Mambo and teaches at Dance Manhattan.

DONNA DE SIMONE — co-owner, director and choreographer of Dance Odyssey and Entertainment Director for Stardust. Donna holds numerous Ballroom and Latin Titles. She has performed throughout the US and China as a solo and ensemble dancer.

JACKIE HORNER — a long standing member of Dance Educators of America, Jackie has an extensive background in Ballroom, Latin and performing arts. She was the story consultant and inspiration for the film "Dirty Dancing".

NICK LECAKES — Nick's 48 year career as an instructor has taken him from Hawaii to Puerto Rico where he was a featured dancer on TV as well as a choreographer. Long affiliated with Arthur Murray in addition to teaching jazz for the last 10 years, he currently works with Dance Manhattan.

NORTON HYMAN — toured the US as a dance professional for over 20 years as a member of the acclaimed dance team Norton and Patricia. Now retired from stage and screen he teaches ballroom dance with his wife AGI in Monticello, NY.

ESTHER ODESCALCHI — began ballroom dancing at the age of twelve in her native Hungary. Currently, she teaches, performs, choreographs and lectures on ballroom dancing. She is a certified Dance Master and member of the NY Society of Teachers of Dancing. She is author of numerous dance-related articles, lectures at colleges and universities.

FRANK ELIA — was a night club performer before joining Dance Educators of America in the 1970's. At present he teaches dance for a number of colleges and Fortune 500 companies in addition to working as a professional DJ. He is associated with various dance studios in Westchester, NY specializing in choreography for wedding couples.

JON GATYAS — is a former competitor and champion who now teaches at his studio in Long Beach, CA. He is a member of the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dance as well as the Royal Academy of Dance. He travels the world over leading groups to the ultimate in dance destinations.

KELVIN ROCHE — has been a fixture on the competition circuit and makes frequent appearances on stage, television and film ("Dance With Me"). He and partner Lori Ann Greenhouse placed first at the 2005 International Hustle and Salsa competition held at DanceSport where Kelvin has taught since 1994.

MARIBEL MALDONADO — is a talented dancer, instructor, choreographer and performer. She has performed in concert with Tito Puente, the Fania All Stars and with the RMM Concert series at Madison Square Garden. She and her partner Nelson Flores are in demand throughout the world as guest instructors and performers.

TALÍA CASTRO-POZO — formerly, "Peruvian Ballet representative to the world", Talia has trained with top teachers globally in all styles of dance. As a performer she has traveled all over the world performing in all dance styles. Talia continues to travel as a performer, consulting dance studios, coaching students and professionals. She is a William Esper Studio graduate, Member of the International Dance Council and currently Stepping Out Studios Co-Director.

LEE VAN BRADLEY — has been teaching and dancing ballroom professionally for over 15 years. He specializes in both American and International styles. He travels as a dance coach and dance consultant, working with all age groups, amateurs and professionals.

NORMA GRANOFSKY — has been teaching ballroom dancing for all of her adult life. She has taught master classes for Dance Educators of America, performed at Madison Square Garden and recently choreographed a show at Westbury Music Fair. She currently teaches independently on Long Island, NY.

SERGEI SLUSSKY & POLINA KIRILLOVA — currently compete professionally in international standard and Latin. Together, they successfully operate the American Ballroom Dance Academy which is a chain of ballroom dance studios in the state of Maine, where they present the complete range of Ballroom and Latin dances of both styles. They are members of the Imperial Society of Teachers of Dance.

GEORGE MADERSKI — In 1974, he performed with the Joffrey Ballet and in 1986 and 1988 with the American Ballroom Theater. He won first place in theatrical and cabaret at the American Star Ball, The Professional Harvest Moon Ball, and second place at the Texas Challenge, as well as Classeque Du Quebec. He has taught for Fred Astaire, Arthur Murray, and many independent dance studios. At present, he teaches privately in Merrick, NY.

FIDEL E. GONZÁLEZ — has been dancing since he was a child in Ecuador and taught for both Arthur Murray and Dance World Studios. He has taught all styles in studios and privately for close to 20 years. Today he is a sought-after private instructor in the DC metro area. Competent and well-grounded in all styles of dance, it is the Latin dances, especially Salsa, Cha Cha, Rumba and Merengue that remain particularly close to his heart.

LORIANN GREENHOUSE — began dancing at the age of 4, studying Ballet, Theater Arts and Ballroom at the Royal Academy of Dance for 15 years. She has performed and competed in China, Japan, Brazil, Argentina and Canada. She holds many Rising Star titles, is a 3-time World Hustle champion and was a finalist in both American Rhythm and Theater Arts. At Blackpool, she placed 5th in the world in Theater Arts.

DIEGO BLANCO & ANA PADRON — were featured performers in "Tango Fever" and "Sensual Tango Review" as well as "Tango Undressed". They placed 2nd at the US Tango Congress, took 3rd place at the World Tango competition and were awarded 1st place in the competition hosted by the National Foundation for Advancement in the Arts.

MAGGIE MOON — In her more than 11 years of swing dancing, Maggie has held multiple national and international championship titles including World Lindy Hop Champion. She has traveled around the world to teach and perform in major national and international cities. She began her Lindy Hop career in San Francisco, but now is a New Yorker.

PAOLO PASTA LANNA — has toured with Wynton Marsalis, The Lincoln Center Jazz Orchestra, Swing Dance America, Forever Swing and The Big Band Musical Revue. He continues to hone his knowledge and skills of classic American dances by teaching and performing throughout the world. Paolo is a co-founder of events such as the Summer Jamboree Dance Camp in Italy, Central Park Swings and Swing Remix.

NELSON FLORES — His dancing and choreography skills have taken him across Europe, South America and the Far East where he has performed with Tito Puente, Tito Nieves, Celia Cruz, India, El Gran Combo and "El Canario" Jose Alberto to name a few! He is now the director of his own dance group, Descarga Latina Dance Company.

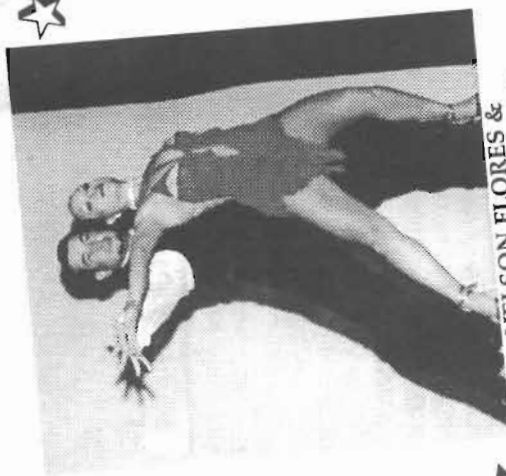

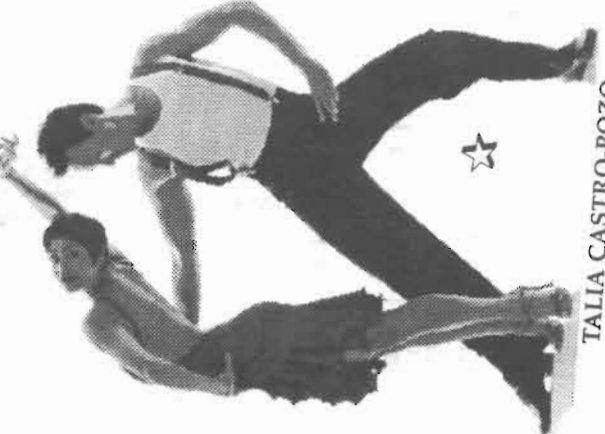

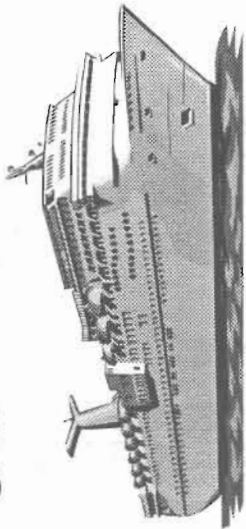
